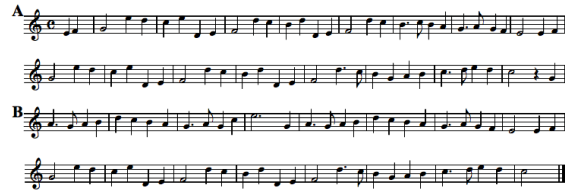


# East Anglian Traditional Music Trust

## The Ruddock Bursaries 2020-21

The East Anglian Traditional Music Trust are delighted to announce the 2020 Ruddock Bursary Scheme is open for application from 31<sup>st</sup> January 2020.

We have 4 bursaries of up to £250\* available to youths up to 25 years old. You must have been raised, be living or studying in East Anglia and be already involved in some form of Traditional Folk Arts – be it in music, song, dance or storytelling. **\*One of these bursaries is to support most of the cost of one youth place at the Burwell Bash ([www.burwellbash.info](http://www.burwellbash.info)) which is an annual Folk Music Summer School run in Cambridgeshire (27<sup>th</sup> July - 31<sup>st</sup> July 2020).**

Aside from the Burwell Bash bursary, the remaining bursaries can be used for anything which would be considered helpful for the continuation of your involvement in this area of Traditional Folk Arts – for example, to cover the cost of workshops, instrument costs, travel expenses to lessons.

Applications are open from 31<sup>st</sup> January 2020 with the closing date of 25<sup>th</sup> March 2020.
